
PUBLIC MEETING TO REVIEW FIRST DRAFT OF PROPOSED CITY/MFD JOINT USE
FACILITY ON UNION PACIFIC PROPERTY

City Manager Kathy Fitzpatrick and Mosier Fire District Chief Appleton made introductions.

Scott Moreland of Hennebery Eddy Architects, Inc., Portland, presented a PowerPoint summary of the 103-page Draft Feasibility Report and Budget Summary. Terry More of the MFD Station Development Committee assisted him via phone conference.

Moreland explained that this was the first time the report had been released for review by “everyone”: the public, the City and MFD. The report is available as a PDF file on the MFD website. Moreland said the report covers three potential versions of the building, estimated costs, geotechnical issues, etc. He said this presentation will be informal and encouraged feedback from everyone present. An exchange between the public, local officials and the consultants followed. During questions on funding, Appleton said he and Moore had traveled to the Salem office of Rep. John Huffman recently to request \$750,000 for the proposed development. Moore noted that Wasco County had selected the joint use facility as its highest priority for its 2017 Community Enhancement Project Priority List. Another discussion related to possible funding from Union Pacific as a result of negotiations with Team Mosier. The amount of the settlement is currently unknown. Moore cautioned the City and MFD to wait to find out how much funding may be coming from UPRR and Wasco County before making a decision on the facility.
