BURN BAN IS APPROACHING!

Have piles to burn?

If so, you only have another month before burn piles are restricted through the end of summer. **As of June 1, only approved burn barrels and incinerators are allowed. As of July 1, all outdoor burning is banned through the arrival of fall rains.** Some burn piles may be allowed after June 1 by written exception, but you must apply to the Fire Chief for this exception.

Burn permits are free and required for all outdoor burning in the Mosier Fire District. Please call the Fire Chief with any questions or concerns. 541-478-3333.
