## **Medical calls** in June:

- **Chest pain**, downtown Mosier, on scene in four minutes.
- **Difficulty breathing**, u-pick customer, on scene in ten minutes.
- **Altered mental status**, near District boundary, on scene in four minutes.
- **Medic alarm activation**, authorized cancel within two minutes.
- **Injury vehicle crash**, Hwy 30, on scene in seven minutes.

## **Fire calls** in June:

- **6/9**: Called to assist Mid-Columbia Fire and Rescue for an unattended **burn pile** a half-mile outside Mosier Fire District, eastbound on I-84. No incident found at the reported location.
- **6/15**: Called to a report of "six people carrying an unconscious person" near milepost 71, westbound on I-84. No incident found at the reported location.

## **BURN BAN IN EFFECT!**

**As of July 1, all outdoor burning is banned until the arrival of fall rains.**

The July 1 cutoff was established by Oregon Department of Forestry in 2007, in consultation with local fire agencies.

The ban is lifted by announcement in the fall when conditions allow, not on a fixed date.
