SELECTED CALL DETAILS

Medical calls in July:

- Difficulty breathing, downtown Mosier, on scene in four minutes
- Difficulty breathing, downtown Mosier, on scene in four minutes
- High blood pressure and nausea, downtown Mosier, on scene in five minutes
- Heart problem, south end of District, on scene in seven minutes

Fire calls in July:

- **7/11:** Grass and brush fire, Hood River Road, on scene in two minutes. This fire was caused by a cottonwood tree falling onto powerlines. Fortunately, terrain and roads prevented the fire from running downwind on a very windy day. No homes were immediately threatened. Crews from Mosier, Oregon Department of Forestry, and US Forest Service easily stopped the portion of the fire which was backing uphill into the wind. The final burned area was eight acres.

BURN BAN IN EFFECT!

As of July 1, all outdoor burning is banned until the arrival of fall rains.

The July 1 cutoff was established by Oregon Department of Forestry in 2007, in consultation with local fire agencies.

The ban is lifted by announcement in the fall when conditions allow, not on a fixed date.
