Medical calls in December:

- **Difficulty breathing, possible kidney failure**, out of District off State Rd, on scene in eighteen minutes.
- **Person lying next to railroad tracks**, downtown Mosier, on scene in two minutes.
- **Possible heart attack**, one mile south of Mosier, on scene in eight minutes.
- **Broken arm**, out of District in upper Dry Creek Valley, on scene in 13 minutes.

Fire calls in December:

- **11/30: Vehicle crash**, non-injury, Interstate 84 at Mosier Creek, on scene in seven minutes. Pickup vs. semi tractor/trailer. Semi blocked both lanes, steering disabled. Mosier Engine 86 pulled the tractor to safety, re-opening one lane.
- **12/2: Report of a vehicle crash**, Interstate 84 at Exit 69. Canceled within thirty seconds of initial call.

Medical calls in January:

- **Fall injury**, two miles east of Mosier, on scene in four minutes.
- **Fall, no injury**, downtown Mosier, on scene in four minutes.
- **Dislocated knee cap**, downtown Mosier, on scene in three minutes.

Fire calls in January:

- **1/2: Smoke odor** in house, off upper State Rd., on scene in ten minutes. We found an electrical outlet had arced due to overloading with an extension cord.
- **1/8: Arcing power line** due to a wet branch on two wires, downtown Mosier, on scene in three minutes. We provided traffic control until the power company arrived and removed the branch.
