## **Medical calls** in July:

- **Cardiac arrest**, Dry Creek valley, on scene in four minutes. Mosier EMT's and Hood River paramedics resuscitated from asystole after approximately half an hour of ventilation, CPR compressions, and defibrillator analysis. Patient later died in hospital.
- **Altered mental status**, off State Road, on scene in eight minutes.
- **Spray paint in eye**, downtown Mosier, on scene in one minute.

## **Fire / Rescue calls** in July:

- **7/21: Semi v. passenger car**, Interstate 84 eastbound milepost 71.5. On scene in five minutes. Two uninjured persons trapped in the car, wedged between the center divider and the partially jackknifed semi trailer, blocking the fast lane. Mosier engine used our tow chain to pull the trailer free, allowing car occupants to exit their vehicle, and the semi to drive off the roadway.
- **7/31: Brush/grass fire**, Memaloose overlook on Hwy 30. On scene in four minutes. Mosier units knocked the fire down at about 1/8 acre and transferred command to Oregon Department of Forestry for mop-up and investigation. Cause under investigation, indications are smoking may have been a factor.
