Medical calls in May:

- **Vehicle crash with injuries**, I-84 unknown location, canceled en route.
- **Drug overdose**, Memaloose rest stop eastbound, on scene in seven minutes.
- **Chest pain**, off State Road, on scene in eight minutes.
- **ATV crash with injuries**, lower Dry Creek valley, on scene in six minutes.
- **Chain saw accident**, upper Dry Creek valley, on scene in seven minutes.
- **Seizure**, lower Dry Creek valley, on scene in four minutes.

Mosier EMT's set up and managed helicopter landing zones on two separate medical incidents in May, once at the Mayer State Park boat ramp and once in the middle of State Road adjacent to our upper Station Two, both in the middle of the night. We have portable LED beacons for this purpose, and we have practiced the procedure with Life Flight crews on several occasions, ensuring good communication with the flight crew and efficient, safe arrival and departure of the helicopter ambulance. Use of Mosier EMT's for this purpose allows ground ambulance crews to focus on patient care. Both Life Flight activations resulted in good patient outcomes.

Fire / Rescue calls in May:

- **5/20: Smoke detector activation**, Hwy 30 east, on scene in three minutes. Quickly determined to be caused by saw dust from a floor sander, no indication of fire or smoke. No further action taken.
