Medical calls in March:

- **Fall with injuries**, out of District, on scene in seven minutes.

Chief Appleton also assisted a non-critical person transported by private car to the Emergency Room, for what turned out to be a serious infection.

On Monday, March 23, Mosier personnel landed a helicopter ambulance for the fourth time in the last eight months on emergency scenes. Previously, we landed helicopters twice in the last eight years.
